

Here are some guidelines:
For every square you complete, tell
a librarian and they'll initial it for

Complete a row, column, or diagonal and bring your Bingo to the library to win a prize bag and a book of your choice. (Limit of I bag per teen).

Note that if you can't complete a square in order to fill out a whole row, you can substitute reading for 30 minutes for that square.
